ACHIEVEMENT FOR 2021

1. Social needs

1.1 Iftar food packages

The AMF engaged in the distribution of iftar food packages during the Holy Month of Ramadan to provide for essential items such as rice, beans, cooking oil, flour, spaghetti and dates to families in need such as orphans, widows, elderly, women and men.

Through the generosity and support of individuals, family and friends and in partnership with other corporate companies such as Zanzibar Port Authority (ZPA) and People's Bank of Zanzibar (PBZ), we successfully distributed 1,670 iftar food packages to the vulnerable and underprivileged families in Mkuranga, Pwani Region, Dar es Salaam Region and Unguja, Zanzibar despite all COVID-19 challenges in 2021.

1.2 Water and sanitation

1.2.1 Kandwi School water well project

Through the support of family and friends, AMF successfully provided a water well for the 777 pupils. Access to clean water; sanitation and hygiene at the school helped resolve most of the other safety and sanitary issues and challenges that the pupils were facing. The local community has access to this school water well and therefore also benefiting from it to 1,000 people in Pwanimchangani, Unguja (Zanzibar).

1.2.2 Mkuranga, Pwani Region water well project

In partnership with Assalaam Foundation, we provided a water well in Mkuranga, Pwani Region at the town center market area. The water well serves 1,700 people.

1.2.3 Unguja, Zanzibar water well

AHM built 2 water well towers with reservoir tanks in Dunga, Unguja to serve the community masjid. This provides access to clean and safe water to the local community masjid and the locals who live in that area.

1.2.4 Safe toilets, sanitation and hygiene

Working in partnership with Exim Bank, AHM renovated 7 toilets at Kandwi School which helped provide the pupils communal latrines and stopped going to defecate in the bushes which was not just unhygienic but also not secure. This stopped the risks of spreading serious diseases such as cholera, dysentery, diarrhea etc and for girl pupils and women, stopped vulnerability to abuse and sexual assault.

1.3 Shelter

Construction of house for widow and orphans. The AMF with the support of friends and families renovated and completed the construction of a house for orphans in Unguja, Zanzibar. The house is providing care, support and general security for 11 orphans who live with their mother.

1.4 Clothing

Working in partnership with Muzdalifa Charitable Organisation and helping hand U.S.A, AMF distributed 800 clothing items for vulnerable and underprivileged families especially girls and women in villages in Pemba and Unguja, Zanzibar.

In partnership with Tuelekezane Peponi Group from Oman, AHM provided clothing (sweaters) to Danai Primary and Secondary School, Dodoma to 1000 students in May, 2021.

1.5 Education

Support pupils with special needs – blinds. AMF supported the blinds including pupils by providing them with walking sticks and typewriter (Braille) for the blind. With the support from Bongo Zozo AHM also repaired 50 braille which enabled students at Uhuru Mchanganyiko in Dar es Salaam, to continue with their studies.

1.6 Healthcare

1.6.1 Distribution of healthcare equipment

Working in partnership with Muzdalifa Charitable Organisation and Helping hands U.S.A, AMF distributed health care equipment

worth of USD 300,000 for both Unguja and Pemba hospital.

1.6.2 Distribution of medical sinks to Mkuranga Hospital

AHM provided medical sinks to the Mkuranga hospital in Mkuranga, Pwani Region which will help serve 800 women per month of the hospital's maternal building.

1.6.3 Distribution of sanitary pads

AMF launched a campaign "Nistiri, Nisifedheheke" (Maintain my Dignity) to distributing free sanitary pads to adolescent vulnerable and underprivileged school girls, new mothers and female prisoners. AMF distributed 600 free sanitary pads to schools girls in Unguja, Zanzibar, Dar es Salaam and Mkuranga, Pwani Region.

2. Women empowerment

2.1 Sowing machine project

On International women's day 08 March 2021, donated a sowing machine to a girl who had completed her sowing education but was unable to find employment. The sowing machine will help the girl and her mother improve their livelihood and independence.

2.2 Small capital

AMF provided a small business capital to a mother to help her grow and maintain her food vending business of chapatis which was about to close due to rising costs of food ingredients.
